

BY-LAWS
Of
LINDEN HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL
revised edition 10-21-24
Established and adopted 10-24-24

ARTICLE I

NAME:

- Linden Heights Community Council shall also be known as Linden Heights DYT on Instagram, Linden Heights Neighborhood Association on Facebook and thelindenheights.weebly.com, on our organization's website.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE:

- The purpose of the LHCC can be modified and any changes discussed at a council meeting. Any changes shall then be voted on at the next scheduled monthly meeting.

ARTICLE III

BOUNDARIES:

- Linden Heights neighborhood boundaries are defined and established by the city of Dayton.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP:

- Annual dues are \$10 per individual, business or organization. The dollar amount for dues shall be reviewed not less than every three (3) years and is subject to change pending a vote at the general council meeting.
- Annual dues must be paid in January of each calendar year. New members after January shall pay dues at the time of joining LHCC to partake in membership and voting privileges for that year.

ARTICLE V

VOTING PRIVILEGES:

- Annual Dues are defined by calendar year.

ARTICLE VII

ELECTION OF COUNCIL OFFICERS:

- Voting for officers will be by a show of hands. A motion may be made to hold an anonymous vote by paper ballot.
- Any member can declare themselves or nominate another member for candidacy for office.
- Candidates are to be present at the September council meeting and be open to questions from the council.
- Paper ballots, if used, will be collected and counted by the Secretary on odd calendar years and the Treasurer on even calendar years.

ARTICLE VIII

REMOVAL OF OFFICERS:

- Voting to remove officers will be by a show of hands. A motion may be made to hold an anonymous vote by paper ballot.
- Paper ballots, if used, will be collected and counted by the Secretary or the Treasurer.

ARTICLE IX

MONIES:

- Treasurer shall report or give access to detailed account information as requested by any Council Officer.

ARTICLE X

- Monthly meetings are held on the last Thursday of each month, excluding November and December.
- Any changes or amendment to the Constitution or By-laws should be brought before the council by any active member at a regular meeting, reviewed by the council and voted upon.
